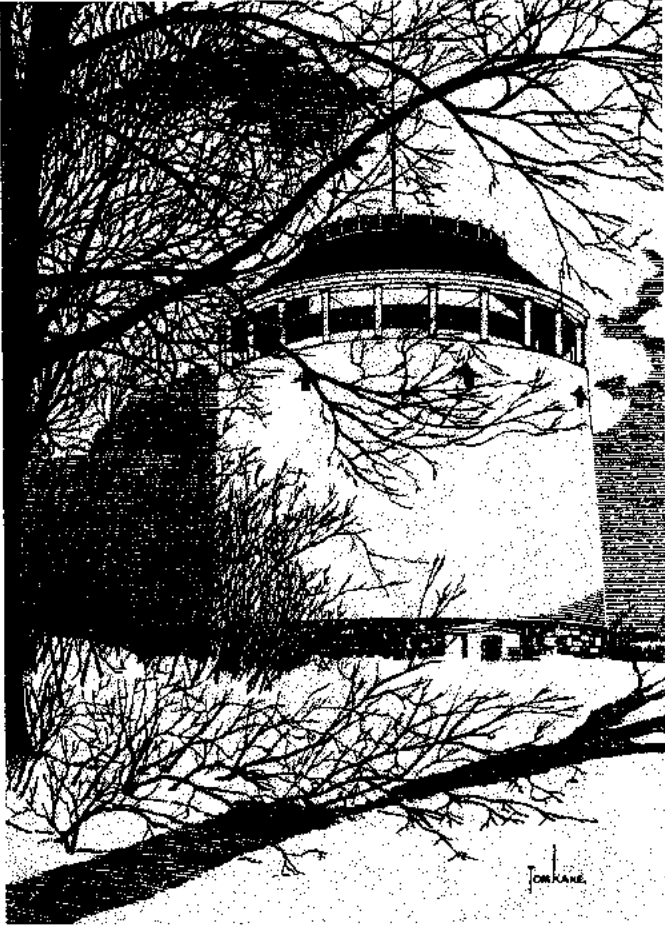

# Thomas Hill Standpipe Recognition



**1974:**

Designated as a National Historic Landmark by the Register of Historic Places and the Maine Historic Preservation Commission

**1980:**

Designated as an American Water Works Association landmark

**2008:**

Designated by the American Society of Civil Engineers as a state historic landmark
